Notes on Declaration of Interest

In such circumstances, the member must withdraw from the meeting room, and should inform the Chairman accordingly. It is not practical to offer detailed advice during the meeting on whether or not a personal interest should be declared, or whether a personal interest should be regarded as prejudicial.
